CREATING YOUR OSCARS IMOVIE TRAILER

BEFORE YOU BEGIN YOUR TRAILER:

- 1. Mrs. Newell and Mrs. Hixon will show you how to upload photos and videos you have found for your topic into an OSCARS 2013 folder in Sky Drive.
- 2. Mr. Zielinski will help you take the photos out of Sky Drive and put them into iMovie.
- 3. Mr. Zielinski will show you how to take the photos out of iMovie and into a new trailer.

HOW TO START A NEW TRAILER:

- 1. Go to file new project
- 2. Under "Movie Trailers" select the style you would like to use. MAKE SURE THE NUMBER OF CAST MEMBERS MATCHES THE NUMBER OR NOMINEES FOR YOUR OSCARS CATEGORY.
- 3. Name your trailer with the OSCARS AWARD CATEGORY you are making the movie for.
- 4. Hit the "create" button.

CREATING YOUR TRAILER: OUTLINE SECTION

- 1. Start with the "Name and Date" section:
 - a. "Movie Name" should be the name of your OSCARS CATEGORY.
 - b. "Release Date" should be March 2013
- 2. Next, do the "Cast" section:
 - a. "Cast Members" should be the names of the nominees for your category. Match up the gender with the character.
- 3. Next, do the "Studio" section:
 - a. Studio Name should be "Walt Disney Elementary OSCARS"
 - b. "Logo Style" is up to you! Choose what you like $\ensuremath{\textcircled{}}$

- 4. Finally, do the "Credits" section:
 - a. "Written By" section should have your name.
 - b. "Directed By" should have your partner's name.
 - c. "Casting By" should be "Walt Disney Elementary Students"
 - d. The rest of the categories should have the NAMES OF THE NOMINEES AND THE BOOKS THEY ARE FROM/HAVE WRITTEN

CREATING YOUR TRAILER: STORYBOARD SECTION

- 1. You will need to edit the text to fit your pictures and video clips:
 - a. The first text box at the top of the section should read "DISNEY ELEMENTARY OSCARS".
 - b. The last TWO text boxes should remain untouched (they should say the OSCARS category you are making the iMovie for and the CREDITS).
 - c. The other text boxes in between are up to you. Include names of characters, authors, and books in the text boxes to go with your photos and video clips. You may also include things like, "Coming this March...only one can win!"
- 2. Drag the photos and videos you uploaded from the Sky Drive into the appropriate spots in the trailer. MAKE SURE YOUR TEXT FITS YOUR PICTURES AND VIDEO CLIPS.

CREATING YOUR TRAILER: SHOT LIST

This section shows all the photos and video clips that you put into the Storyboard Section. Use this section to quickly view what you have included. You can insert and change pictures and video clips in this area as well as in the storyboard area.

WHEN YOU THINK YOU ARE DONE ...

- Make sure you watch your trailer all the way through at least TWICE so you are sure it looks the way you want it to. DOUBLE CHECK THAT ALL WORDS ARE SPELLED CORRECTLY!!!
- 2. Make sure that Mrs. Newell or Mrs. Hixon has seen the trailer.
- 3. Ask Mr. Zielinski how you need to SAVE your trailer.
