- Paragraph 1 is your introduction. Mention your state name and your marvel you have chosen.
- Paragraph 2 in the body might include details <u>all about your</u> REGION:
 - Location of your state in the United States (N, S, E, or W part of the country)
 - o What Region your state is located in?
 - Bordering states/ countries or major lakes, rivers or oceans near by.
 - Climate of your region
- Paragraph 3 in the body (zoom in and focus on the STATE).
 - The year of induction (became) a state
 - The capital of your state
 - Any fun and interesting facts from your state!
 - Sports teams
 - Famous people that were born there
 - Important places to that state
 - o Give lots of details!!
- Paragraph 4 in the body (zoom in and focus on your MARVEL) include details of your marvel you have picked.
 - Paragraph 4 Date your marvel was built (if known)
 - Describe what your marvel looks like

- Describe how people use your marvel or what the purpose of it is
- o How did your marvel get its name?
- Compare your marvel to now and what it use to look like (sometimes they have been renovated (redone) or maybe it is no longer there!)
- Paragraph 5: Conclusion Wrap it up and restate your state name and marvel!

When you share your report and project with the class, I will have the Big USA map down. You will have to be able to come up to the map and point out where your state is and the region you are located in. Be able to point out the location on a map. You will have to do this for the class during your presentation.
