Part 2: Project/Presentation:

Choose only <u>one</u> of the four following projects: You will present your project at our USA Marvels Museum for the entire school and your parents to see. The project portion of your marvel is done on YOUR own time at home!! You may work on the writing at school, but if you are not able to finish all of it at school you will have to finish it at home.

Travel Brochure

Must include:

- Historical and current information about the location
- A Map or your state or Marvel
- Colored Pictures (you may draw them or use real pics!) must include captions to describe your pictures.
- Tells cost if any to attend this place
- Gives time and days available
- Must be neat and easy to read and understand
- You are trying to persuade me to come visit your marvel (See me for an example of a brochure)

Poster

Must include:

- · Has a clearly written title on the top introducing your marvel
- Must have some written historical information as well as current information about your marvel.
- Has colored pictures of the place or thing you have picked as your marvel (you may draw them or use pictures from the internet)
- You may include pictures of yourself if you've been there.
- Is very detailed
- Is neat and easy to read

Create an educational game to play: Must include:

- Must have all facts related to your marvel you have picked
- Answers must be correct and very detailed
- Have directions on how to play the game
- Make a game board and all the pieces needed to play the game

- Must be very neat and able to read.
- You may use pieces or game boards from other games and redesign them to fit with your marvel.

Create a miniature model Must include:

- You may be as creative as you want
- Your miniature model must look like the marvel of the place or thing you have picked
- Must be very neat and detailed
- You don't have to spend money on this project. Try to find things around the house to build your model or make your game!
